### **BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT PLAN**

The following plan will be enforced throughout the year. This is necessary in order to provide all students with an opportunity to enjoy an environment that is conducive to learning. The student will start each day on a GREEN smiley ☺ face-A Great Day! From that point, depending on behavior and after several warnings they may be moved to a YELLOW face- Warning. After that, should negative behavior continue, they move to a BLUE face- Ten Minute Recess Loss. The final move would be to a RED face- Phone Call or Note Home to be signed. Students who stay on Green will be rewarded at various times.

**3 or more notes/calls home in one month will mean a visit to the office.**
